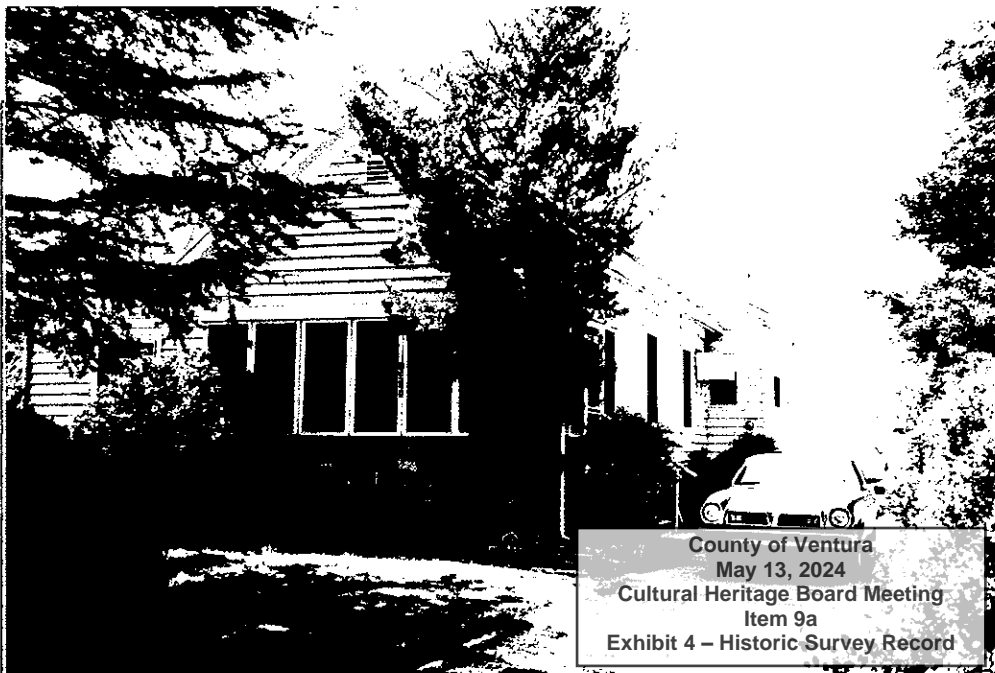

DESCRIPTION

7a. Architectural style: 1900s gabled roof residence with wide board siding

7b. Briefly describe the present physical description of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

Basically rectangular in shape, this single story residence has a high gable with a sidefacing gable wing. In the rear is another higher gable addition. The eaves are boxed. The front porch is recessed under the main gable and enclosed with the lower portion of concrete block and the upper portion of screened windows. The entrance is on the side with concrete steps and iron railing. Remaining windows are double hung with raised wood mouldings. The house rests on a concrete foundation and is covered with wide board siding.

SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)

This house was built in the late 1890s or 1900. It is uncertain who the original owner was, but the name of J.R. McKee has been given by early resident Harold Dorman. Mr. McKee was the land agent for Thomas Bard. The house was supposed to have been originally located at the southeast corner of Bardsdale Ave. and Simi Street. In 1912 Lewis Henry owned that property. It was moved to its present location between 1951 and 1954.
